The History Graduate Degree at PNW can be completed entirely online and can be combined with existing coursework from the Teach Dual Credit Indiana program.

Purdue University Northwest DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

- 33 Total Credit Hours
- 12 Credit Hours at the 600 level
- 11 Required Classes at the 500 or 600 level

WHY DUAL CREDIT?

Through Teach Dual Credit Indiana, teachers can take graduate courses to meet the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) dual credit credentialing requirements at no cost to them. Teach Dual Credit Indiana covers the full cost for tuition, books, and fees at partner institutions for eligible content areas.

FAQ: How to complete a master's degree if I am taking classes at a higher ed other than PNW?

A: If a teacher completes 18 credits (six courses) through Teach Dual Credit Indiana, s/he needs only 15 credits (five courses) to complete an MA degree. At least 51% of the degree must be completed at PNW, so interested teachers can transfer in up to 15 credits (5 graduate classes) from other institutions.
