ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A baccalaureate or graduate degree from a college or university that is accredited by a recognized accrediting agency.
- A bachelor's degree in the major content area of master's you are seeking.
- An undergraduate GPA of 2.75 or higher from the baccalaureate degree granting institution at which at least a minimum of 30 hours was completed.
- A valid (but not necessarily current) state teacher's license with an endorsement to teach in the major content area of master's you are seeking, or a valid (but not necessarily current) temporary, standard, or professional teaching license/certificate from another recognized accreditation body (e.g., Association of Christian Schools International), or an official letter from a school administrator confirming employment as a teacher of record.
- At least one year of teaching experience from an approved and accredited public, private, or parochial P-12 school in the United States or abroad.
- Supporting documentation demonstrating access to a P-12 classroom.
